

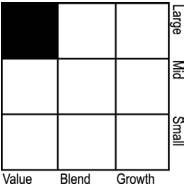

The Morningstar Style Box™ reveals a fund's investment strategy by showing its investment style and market capitalization based on the fund's portfolio holdings.

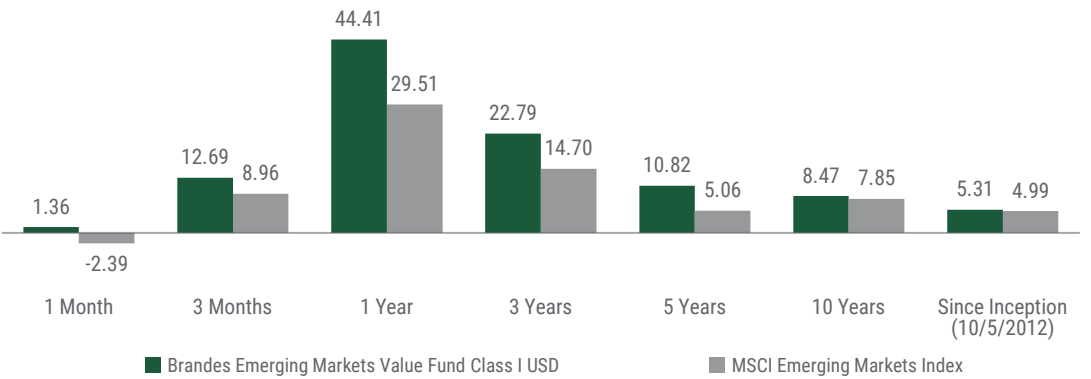

- Fund Objective:** Long-term capital appreciation by investing in equity and equity related securities of issuers located or active mainly in emerging markets whose equity market capitalizations exceed \$3 billion at the time of purchase. - Investment Approach:** Brandes Investment Partners is a bottom-up, value-oriented global equity and fixed income manager. Brandes believes that a strategy of buying businesses at a discount to the firm's estimate of their true value has the potential to produce competitive long-term results. The sub-fund is considered to be actively managed in reference to the MSCI Emerging Markets Index by virtue of the fact that it uses the MSCI Emerging Markets Index for performance comparison purposes.
